


# Good Dads

One of the most crucial and formative steps to forming a sustainable Good Dads Chapter is to build an effective **Advisory Board**.

Your chapter's board should represent a diverse group of varying perspectives. But they should all have one thing in common: a vested interest in supporting engaged fatherhood.

Aim to have two individuals from each of these six sectors represented on your Advisory Board (twelve total members). Each sector brings something unique to your father initiative:

**Education** – Support for programs serving fathers and students.

**Business & Manufacturing** – HR supplies, support dollars and funding classes for at-risk dads.

**Faith Community** – Volunteers, facilitators and classroom space.

**City/County Government** – Public support and access to policy leaders.

**Law Enforcement/Judicial** – Program referrals and public support.

**Social Services** – Program referrals, facilitators and classroom space.
